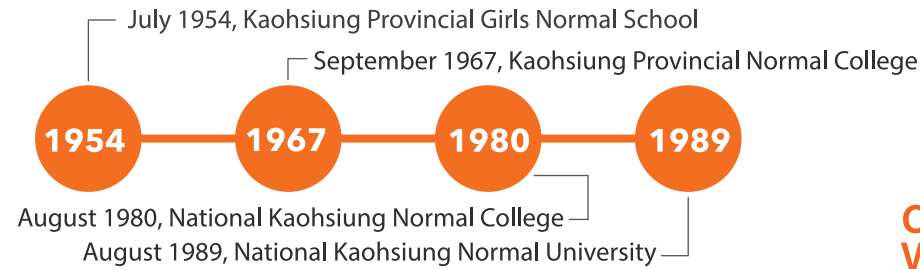

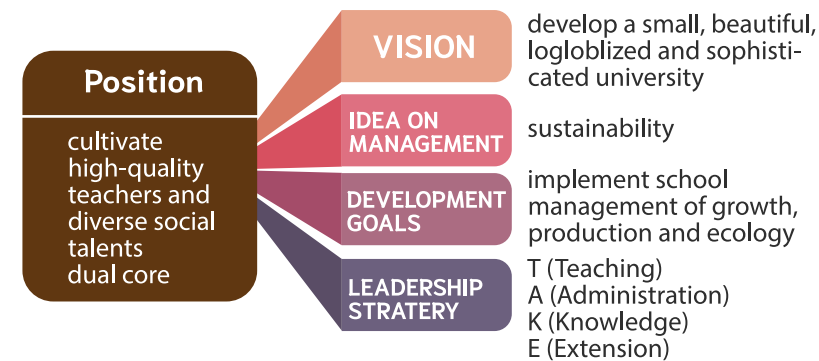
Educational Positioning

- Preservice teacher trainees are required to complete an educational curriculum to facilitate passing teacher certification, completing internships, and obtaining teacher qualifications.
- Non-teacher trainees can also participate in selection tests to qualify for the educational curriculum.
- Undergraduate students can apply to study interdisciplinary credit programs, minors, or double degrees, showcasing diverse expertise in the field of education or various professional sectors.
